Each year the classes compete to build the best Christmas Hamper—to be independently judged and the winning class receive a prize.

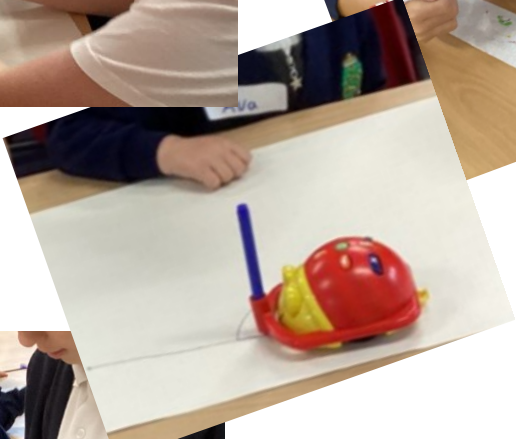

Donations to the hampers can be brought into school from next week.

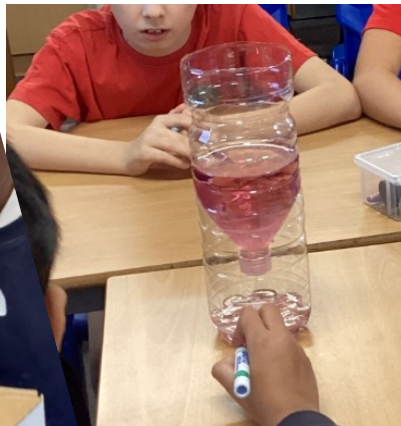
